Nigeria

Christians living in perpetual fear

More than 150 people have been killed since last Friday in central and northern Nigeria, in separate attacks on villages populated largely by Christians.

On 14 March, gunmen raided three villages in Kaduna state, killing at least 114 people, most of whom were burned beyond recognition. The following Sunday, about 35 people were killed and a church was attacked in raids on several villages in Taraba

state. The Fulani, a largely Muslim, West African ethnic group of herdsmen with a history of land grievances against Nigeria's indigenous Christians and others, are suspected of both attacks.

Separately on Sunday, militants suspected to be part of the militant Islamist group, Boko Haram, killed two people in Pela Birni village in Borno state. Two churches and a number of houses were burned.

A spokesman for Nigeria's president has said that the conflict with Boko Haram is a 'war situation'.

Open Doors' Project 'Endure Pressure' is bringing relief aid and encouragement to Christians affected

by Boko Haram activity. One of the team said, "We want to encourage believers... and remind them that the larger body of Christ is concerned about their situation and is praying for them day and night."
